AGE

Since children who have reached the use of reason (circa 7 years old) are considered, for purposes of Christian initiation, to be adults (canon 852.1), their formation should follow the general pattern of the ordinary catechumenate as far as possible. They should receive the sacraments of baptism, confirmation and Eucharist at the Paschal Vigil together with the older catechumens. An initiation inventory for children is under a separate cover.

PRIOR BAPTISM

1. Obtain a baptismal certificate.

2.

- *a.* a. Orthodox (Greek, Russian, Coptic, Ukrainian, Armenian, et al.) are to be received into full communion in the corresponding Eastern Rite. Consult the Diocesan Chancery.
- *b.* Episcopalian, Methodist, Lutheran, Presbyterian are validly baptized (no re-baptism permitted) and when received into the Catholic Church are to be confirmed and admitted to Eucharist.
- c. Baptist, Salvation Army, Jehovah's Witnesses, Pentecostal, Unitarian, etc are baptisms not to be accepted without question. It must be shown that baptism was administered in the name of the Trinity (Father, Son and Holy Spirit), and also that true baptism took place and not just a "dedication."
- 3. Note: Those baptized in a Christian tradition other than Catholic are not to be baptized conditionally unless, after an examination of the matter and the form of the words used in the conferral of baptism and after a consideration of the intention of an adult baptized person and of the minister of the baptism, a serious reason for doubting the validity of the baptism is present.
- 4. When there is a reasonable and prudent doubt concerning the baptism of such Christians which cannot be resolved after serious investigation into the fact and/or validity of baptism, namely, to ascertain whether the person was baptized with water and with the Trinitarian formula, and whether the minister and the recipient of the sacrament had the proper requisite intentions, and if conditional baptism seems necessary, this must be celebrated privately rather than at a public liturgical assembly of the community. The reception into full communion should take place later at the Sunday liturgy of the community.

PRIOR CONFIRMATION

The validity of confirmation in other Christian faith traditions is not recognized (unless the person has been confirmed/Chrismated in the Orthodox Church, in this case, please consult the Diocesan Chancery). Upon reception into the Catholic Church the person is to be confirmed prior to receiving Eucharist.

PREVIOUS MARRIAGE

A Decree of Nullity must be obtained from the Diocesan Tribunal of the Chancery if the marriage is invalid because of Lack of Form.

For any other marriages, consult the Diocesan Tribunal before the person may be admitted to the sacraments of initiation.
